

Frost & Sullivan says WSN gaining ground but slow adoption

A recent market report by Frost & Sullivan says eventhough wireless sensors are rapidly gaining ground in industrial sectors such as building automation and industrial automation, the adoption of this technology has been relatively slow. Further, the study mentions that the total wireless sensor revenues were \$160 million in 2005 and it can reach \$1850 million in 2012.
